
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of the Pasadena Area Community College District, licensee of KPCC-FM, I am writing to request a one (1) year extension of the experimental broadcast authorization granted on September 12, 2005 pursuant to Section 73.1510 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. Sec. 73.1510. In anticipation of the Commission's permanent authorization of digital radio multicasting, the station is continuing to transmit a hybrid digital signal incorporating multiple digital audio channel as part of iBiquity Digital Corporation's In-Band On-Channel (IBOC) digital transmission system for FM broadcasting.
