Los Angeles (2011) A teacher is charged with sexual misconduct. (Miramonte)	Yes	Yes
Sacramento (March 24, 2012) Fifth grade teacher and aide allegedly held a student's arms behind his back, and covered his mouth with duct tape as punishment for "talking too much".	No, unless holding hands behind back is considered violence.	Yes
Los Angeles (March 28, 2012) Teacher calls student "Jew Boy" and made other offensive remarks.	No	Yes
San Diego (March 14, 2012) High School teacher makes 14 year old female student urinate in a bucket in front of other students including male classmates.	No	Yes
Oxnard (March 7, 2011) Middle school teacher has been placed on administrative leave pending an investigation into rumors that she's also a porn actress.	No	Yes
Redwood City (February 6, 2012) Special-needs teacher allegedly slapped, kicked and refused food and drink to two developmentally disabled boys.	Yes for the slap. No for refusing food or drinks.	Yes
Stockton (November 18, 2011) Special education teacher is on paid administrative leave as an investigation continues into whether she used a school district-issued Apple laptop to run several porn websites.	No	Yes
Forestville (October 12, 2011) Northern California teacher who allegedly gave her students advance copies of questions on a state biology test.	No	Yes
Vacaville (September 29, 2011) Teacher knocks 25 points off of students' grades as a punishment for saying, "God bless you" after other students sneeze.	No	Yes
Livingston (May 24, 2011) Teacher kept explosive material in her classroom.	No	Yes
Oakland (April 16, 2010) Veteran Teacher left his pupils unattended in the classroom and the schoolyard, physically manhandled students, told children to "shut up" and locked one girl in the classroom.	No (Yes if manhandled is considered physical violence. No for locking the children in the classroom.	Yes
Oakland (January 23, 2011) Second grade teacher accused of allowing students to have oral sex in her classroom.	No	Yes

Washington DC (March 13, 2012) Teacher taped a 9 year old student to a chair as punishment for getting out of his seat too many times.	No	Yes
Wisconsin (March 2, 2012) Teacher who looked at porn at school gets job back, with back pay.	No	Yes
New York (February 19, 2012) Teacher "reassigned" after a video of him swatting and spitting on a student surfaced.	No (Yes if swatting is considered violence against student) Spitting would not be covered.	Yes
New York (February 2, 2012) Teacher makes students write Christmas cards to convicted sex offender (teacher's boyfriend).	No	Yes
Ohio (November 17, 2011) Teacher and her aid make inappropriate comments to mentally disabled student. Call her fat, dumb, a liar and tell her this is the cause for her not having friends. They made her run on the treadmill in class when her performance was low and told her she failed a test before it was evaluated.	No	Yes
South Carolina (November 16, 2011) Teacher makes 6 year old students give her foot massages in class.	No	Yes
Florida (May 7, 2002) Teacher locked up 5 year old student in dark room for two hours.	No	Yes
Alabama (October 16, 2011) A special education teacher is under fire after he posted photos of himself on Facebook wearing one of his student's helmets. He mocked children in his second-grade class, making jokes about them going to the bathroom on themselves and eating crayons.	No	Yes
Wisconsin (May 17, 2011) A music teacher at Lincoln Elementary School is on paid leave after a student claims she locked him in a closet.	No	Yes
New Mexico (January 20, 2011) Teacher locked a student in a cage outside classroom surrounded with toxic chemicals.	No	Yes
Illinois (April 25, 2011) When feces is discovered on the floor, teacher makes students drop their pants to find the culprit.	No	Yes
Tennessee (June 1, 2007) Teacher locks 12 year old boy in closet for four hours as a form of timeout. The boy came home with urine and fecal matter on him.	No	Yes
