Change in Dismissal Procedure		
•Notice of dismissal shall be no more than 30 days	No*	Yes

•Allow evidence that occurred more than four years prior to the date of filing the notice to dismiss	No*	Yes
•The Commission on Professional Competence shall be advisory. The Board of Education shall have the final authority	No*	Yes

Note: SB 1059 (Huff) and AB 2028 (Knight/Smyth) have three provisions not in the LAUSD resolution or in Padilla's bill

1. Prohibit any contract from requiring a school district from keeping disciplinary records in a teacher's file for more than 4 years.
2. Requires school districts to remove a teacher if there is reasonable suspension that the teacher is under investigation by law enforcement.
3. Require school boards to put in the record why a teacher is returned to the classroom after they have been removed.

*Only in narrow instances of sex, violent and drug related crimes
